TOUR OF SOUTHERN ITALY

Summer 2025

Tour Dates: May 31-June 13

Participants arrive by afternoon/evening May 31 at our hotel in Fabriano; depart the morning of June 14 from Fabriano.

Payment: deposit reserves your place; remainder is payable upon course confirmation

"Paper, Print and Book" is led by Lynn Sures, Artist, and Giorgio Pellegrini, Fmr. Director of the Museum of Paper and Watermark, Fabriano, Italy. It consists of a tour of Southern Italian sites of note in the areas of papermaking, printmaking, and book arts. This is an opportunity to immerse yourself in the arts and culture of Italy with expert guides.

Course Description: The Tour includes visits to Museum of Writing in Bassiano; Isola del Liri Papermills; the Palace and waterworks of the Reggia di Caserta; Excavations at Pompei; Amatruda Papermill and the Paper Museum at Amalfi; Etruscan Archaeological Park at Paestum; city Carved from and into the Rock at Matera; Portoghese family Printing Museum at Altamura; Museum of Printing and workshop of Lecce; Agropoli (ancient Roman city), Alberobello (trulli buildings), Otranto (rocky coast of the Adriatic), and Ostuni (gleaming white walls).

Cost of \$4,400.00** includes tuition and most materials; hotels, most with full breakfast (**based on double occupancy); transportation on Tour--does not include roundtrip transportation from the US to Fabriano, nor meals.

Lynn will photograph your work for our workshop files. *The itinerary is subject to unforeseen minor adjustments.

<u>**Travel Insurance:**</u> The cost does NOT include travel insurance. Most travel insurance plans typically include coverage for trip cancellation & interruption, emergency medical expense and transportation, lost or damaged baggage and a wide array of 24/7 travel assistance services. Participants are <u>strongly advised</u> to purchase travel insurance prior to their trip.

<u>Covid Policy</u>: Participants will be requested to wear masks on the airline flight, in airports, and on the train to Fabriano; all must test negative before joining us unmasked, to ensure <u>all can enjoy the full tour disease-free</u>.

Confirmation Policy:

Trip will be confirmed as soon as class reaches 5 participants. At this point it will be recommended to plan to purchase air tickets to Italy. Note: return from Rome on 6/14 necessitates evening or next day flight.

Cancellation Policy:
